Cardinal LaCroix Academy Title I Program Abstract 2023-24 School Year

Coordination and Integration

CLA is a Targeted Assistance Title I school and uses Title I funds to support specifically identified students. All Manchester residents are eligible. Students are selected for eligibility based on a rank-order of greatest academic need which may include standardized assessments, phonemic awareness screener, phonics screener, spelling assessment, and teacher recommendation. The Title I teacher provides intervention services for students and supports teachers, so they are best able to work with our most struggling students. Students are seen in small groups or individually.

CLA currently has one Title I teacher to support and teach. The Title I teacher and each classroom teacher meet weekly to discuss whole-class and individual student needs and academic plans.

Instruction

CLA's Math and Literacy Interventions focus on foundational skills and closing the gaps identified in state and screening assessments. Title I supplementary Reading services provide an intense focus on the essential components of literacy instruction: phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension. The supplementary Math instruction provides an intense focus on number sense, place value, and operations.

In an effort to adapt to 21st century learning styles, CLA has used Title I funds to purchase Lexia software and headphones to allow teachers to make use of technology as an interactive and supplemental instructional tool for Title I students.

Community and Families

CLA' Title I teacher will work on developing a strong relationship with our families in an effort to create greater parent involvement. Group and individual meetings will be held as needed and we aim to host or support Title I Information Night, Math Night, Literacy Night, and more.
